What Is Jewish Journeys?

Jewish Journeys is a new program for our Hebrew High students that enables them to participate in various Jewish experiences in our congregation and community. This program is an addition to our 7th-9th grade curriculum. There will be select Sundays throughout the year in which students will not formally meet. In lieu of attending an in-class session, students will be expected to attend **THREE (3)** congregational or community-wide events throughout the school year. For Kulanu students who attend Sunday mornings, we expect attendance at the Jewish Film Festival on October 28 as well as volunteering at the Purim Carnival on March 24.

Examples of approved Jewish Journeys events include:

- Attendance and participation in our Simchat Torah service
- Volunteering at our Purim Carnival
- Attending an “Exploring the World of Judaism” session on Sunday mornings
- Attending a lecture sponsored by the Jewish Federation of Silicon Valley or participating in the community-wide Yom HaAtzmaut program
- Attendance and participation in a youth group event
